

# Vision For Life Enhancement Commitment

The doctors at Richens Eye Center stand behind your vision results and are committed to help you maintain stable results for a lifetime. This assures that if an enhancement is necessary to maintain vision results, qualified participating patients will receive a necessary same technology enhancement procedure without charge.

## **To maintain eligibility in the Vision For Life commitment program:**

1. Complete your course of post-operative exams
2. Complete an annual exam each year with any physician at Richens Eye Center, or with a co-managing optometrist. (patient is responsible for fees associated with each exam)

## **Qualifications:**

1. Treatment Perimeters: Myopia: -0.50 to -13.00, Hyperopia: plano to + 3.00, Cylinder: Up to 3.50 D
2. Complete all post-operative exams as recommended by physician
3. Annual eye exam with a physician at Richens Eye Center or Co-managing Optometrist is required to keep enhancement plan valid.
4. Same procedure (custom for custom) (traditional for traditional)
5. Post operative vision is testing 20/40 or worse.
6. The surgeon deems that an enhancement is safe and necessary and in the best interest of the patient's vision.

## **Disqualifications:**

1. If patient has had any previous eye surgery
2. If patient has any eye disease or condition such as: glaucoma, diabetic retinopathy, retinal detachment, irregular astigmatism, etc.
3. Prescription treated is out of the qualifying treatment ranges listed above in the qualifications.
4. If patient is pregnant or nursing.

## **Standard enhancement policy:**

During the first 9 months after your laser treatment you will receive one same technology enhancement per eye. If the enhancement requires an upgrade in technology (ie: standard to custom), the patient will be charged for the difference between the current retail cost of each procedure. If an enhancement is needed after the 9 month follow-up period it would fall into the Vision For Life Plan.
